




OPERATIONS

FDA authorizes use of new COVID-19 antibody test. The FDA this week issued an <u>emergency use authorization</u> for Abbott Laboratory's SARS-CoV-2 IgG assay for the qualitative detection of COVID-19 antibodies. FDA said that the test may be effective in diagnosing recent or prior infection with SARSCoV-2 by identifying individuals with adaptive immune responses to the virus that causes COVID-19.

FDA accelerates approval for cancer therapy. FDA granted <u>accelerated approval</u> for a new dosing regimen for a cancer therapy that allows patients with certain cancers to continue treatment with fewer in-person visits. The approval was granted more than five months prior to the agency's goal date.

NIH reports promising data on remdesivir for aiding COVID-19 recovery. A trial sponsored by the National Institutes of Health's National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases provided preliminary indications that hospitalized patients with advanced COVID-19 and lung involvement who received remdesivir recovered faster than similar patients who received a placebo. Remdesivir is an investigational, broad-spectrum antiviral treatment administered via daily infusion for 10 days. The randomized, controlled trial, which involved more than 1,000 patients from multiple sites around the world, found that patients who received remdesivir had a 31% faster recovery time, compare with those who received a placebo — 11 days for patients treated with remdesivir, compared with 15 days for those in the control group.

PLANNING

Continue daily reporting of available resources and response data. Organizations reporting to the following systems are considered to be fully reporting resource data in response to the COVID-19 PHE.

- <u>Juvare/EMResource</u>: Continue to report bed availability and ventilator capacity by 8:00 a.m. daily.
- <u>PPE Survey Tool:</u> PPE data will be reported to a <u>new PPE Survey Tool</u> instead of EMResource.
- <u>COVID-19 Patient Survey Tool:</u> Used to collect hospitalization data, and only to be used at the direction of DPHHS officials following acquisition of confirmed COVID-19 patient.

LOGISTICS

Submit PPE needs to DES coordinator in order to ensure allocation. In order to receive an allocation of emergency PPE, healthcare organizations MUST <u>submit needs to their local DES coordinator</u>. Allocation is ongoing and supplies are limited.

FINANCE & ADMINISTRATION

CMS announces additional COVID-19 waivers and rule changes, including modifications for certain provider-based hospital outpatient departments. CMS today announced additional regulatory waivers and rule changes to expand diagnostic testing for Medicare and Medicaid beneficiaries, telehealth in Medicare, hospital capacity and the healthcare workforce during the COVID-19 emergency. Among other items, the changes:

- Allow certain provider-based hospital outpatient departments that relocate off-campus to obtain a temporary exception and continue to be paid at the full outpatient prospective payment system rate, rather than the reduced site-neutral rate;
- Allow hospital outpatient departments to bill for certain Medicare telehealth services
- Expand the types of providers that can furnish Medicare telehealth services to physical and occupational therapists, speech language pathologists and others; and
- Allow more telehealth services to be provided by audio-only connection.

New information on billing for distant site telehealth services. The Medicare Learning Network has revised its article on New and Expanded Flexibilities for RHCs and FQHCs during the COVID-19 emergency. Revisions include new telehealth services that can be provided (including audio only telephone evaluation and management services) and revised bed count methodology for determining the exemption to the RHC payment limit for provider-based RHCs.

CMS announces Independent Commission on Nursing Home Quality Safety. CMS announced a new independent Commission that will conduct a comprehensive assessment of the nursing home response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Additions to EMTALA FAQs. CMS today issued additional <u>FAQs</u> clarifying Emergency Medical Treatment and Labor Act requirements, flexibilities and considerations for hospitals and other providers during the pandemic as outlined in the agency's March <u>memo</u> to state survey agency directors.

Fed expands Main Street Lending Program eligibility, scope. The Federal Reserve Board today expanded eligibility for the Main Street Lending Program to businesses with up to 15,000 employees or \$5 billion in annual revenue. The program previously was limited to companies with up to 10,000 employees and \$2.5 billion in revenue. The board also reduced the minimum loan size for two of the program's loan options to \$500,000 from \$1 million. Although nonprofit organizations are not currently eligible for the program, the board said it "recognizes the critical role that nonprofit organizations play throughout the economy and is evaluating a separate approach to meet their unique needs."

Agencies extend employee benefit deadlines. The departments of Labor and the Treasury are extending certain deadlines affecting employee benefit plan participants' rights to health coverage, portability and continuation of coverage under COBRA, and to file claims or appeal denied claims. DOL's Employee Benefits Security Administration also is extending the time for plan officials to furnish certain notices and disclosures under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act if they make a good faith effort to furnish the documents as soon as administratively practicable. Updated FAQs on Paycheck Protection Program. SBA yesterday updated <u>FAQs</u> for lenders and borrowers regarding the Paycheck Protection Program (PPP). The FAQs clarify SBA's interpretation of the CARES Act, which established PPP, and of PPP interim final rules on eligibility, lender and borrower requirements, maximum loan amount, use of PPP loans, and other issues.
