




House passes \$3 trillion COVID-19 relief package. The House Friday passed the Health and Economic Recovery Omnibus Emergency Solutions (HEROES) Act — a \$3\$ trillion COVID-19 relief package.

The Senate has already indicated it will not take up the <u>House bill</u> in its current form, but what happens next is unclear. Senate Republicans have advocated a

pause in further federal COVID-19 relief action until the impact of previous measures can be assessed. They also have objected to the cost of the House package. That means action on additional relief could be pushed into June. For more information on the healthcare-related provisions of the HEROES Act, see the May 15 edition of the MHA Weekly News Report.

NIH updates COVID-19 Treatment Guidelines. What's New in the Guidelines (page 4) outlines new additions and updates to the <u>treatment guidelines</u>, including antithrombotic therapy, antiviral drugs under evaluation and immunebased therapy under evaluation.

CDC allocates \$10.25B to expand testing. The CDC will award \$10.25 billion from the Paycheck Protection Program and Health Care Enhancement Act to states, localities and territories by May 23 to expand COVID-19 testing and surveillance activities, the agency announced today. PLANNING

State announces changes to data reporting. DPHHS announced changes to data reporting effective May 11. For questions, please contact your <u>Regional</u> Coordinator.

- Hospitals: Continue reporting to Juvare/EMResource as follows:
 - · Daily: Bed and ventilator counts
 - · Weekly (every Friday): PPE
 - Following treatment of COVID-19 patient(s): COVID-19 patient data, as directed by public health officials
- <u>Long-Term Care Facilities:</u> May reduce their bed and PPE reports to the Regional Coordinators to Fridays only. Regional Coordinators will email out a survey link weekly to each facility for bed and PPE data.

LOGISTICS

Save used N95 masks: No-cost service to decontaminate N95 masks. The <u>Battelle presentation</u> from the May 8 webinar includes an overview and FAQs on the program. This no-cost service to Montana healthcare providers allows reuse of N95 masks up to 20x.

Submit PPE needs to DES coordinator in order to ensure allocation. In order to receive an allocation of emergency PPE, healthcare organizations MUST <u>submit needs to their local DES coordinator</u>. Allocation is ongoing and supplies are limited.
