






OPERATIONS

FDA expands PPE use of gowns, shoe covers and other apparel. The FDA last week issued an <u>emergency use authorization</u> (EUA) for the use of certain gowns, shoe covers and other apparel for use by healthcare providers as personal protective equipment (PPE) in healthcare settings in accordance with CDC recommendations.

PLANNING

Continue resource reporting to State. The following reporting requirements are in effect. For questions, please contact your Regional Coordinator.

- Hospitals: Continue reporting to Juvare/EMResource as follows:
 - · Daily: Bed and ventilator counts
 - · Weekly (every Friday): PPE
 - Following treatment of COVID-19 patient(s): COVID-19 patient data, as directed by public health officials
- <u>Long-Term Care Facilities:</u> May reduce their bed and PPE reports to the Regional Coordinators to Fridays only. Regional Coordinators will email out a survey link weekly to each facility for bed and PPE data.

LOGISTICS

Lab offers COVID-19 return-to-work testing services. Quest Diagnostics today announced new workplace services to aid return-to-work efforts, including access to specimen collection options for COVID-19 testing and on-site temperature checks. The lab said it currently has capacity to perform 200,000 antibody tests per day and is ramping up lab operations with the goal of performing 150,000 molecular diagnostic tests per day by the end of June. The CDC warns that antibody tests may not show whether individuals are immune and should not be the sole basis for decisions about a person's return to a workplace.

Streamlined sign-up process for Battelle mask decontamination program. Battelle and Montana DES have simplified the sign-up process for participation in the Critical Care Decontamination System (CCDS) for N95 masks. Get started with the <u>4-step sign-up process</u>.

Submit PPE needs to DES coordinator in order to ensure allocation. In order to receive an allocation of emergency PPE, healthcare organizations MUST <u>submit needs to their local DES coordinator</u>. Allocation is ongoing and supplies are limited.

FINANCE & ADMINISTRATION

FEMA distributing infrared thermometers for workplace use. FEMA is sending more than 438,000 non-contact infrared thermometers from the Strategic National Stockpile to state, territorial and tribal governments to distribute to local authorities and businesses based on their priorities as the nation's workplaces and economy reopen, the agency <u>announced</u> yesterday. FEMA said the thermometers are intended for use by workplaces with high person-to-person interaction in accordance with <u>CDC guidance</u> and <u>OHSA guidance</u> for identifying

potentially ill employees and visitors. The agency expects additional thermometers to be available in June.

Report examines coronavirus-related unemployment claims in Montana.

Montana Department of Labor and Industry recently released its <u>Economy at a Glance</u>. The report examines Montana unemployment claims filed due to COVID-19 including industry and individual impacts. The healthcare industry accounted for the second-highest share of continued claims, at 12%, behind Accommodation & Food at 28% of total claims. Healthcare had the largest increase in continued claim volume relative to the start of March with a 2250% increase.

OIG releases plan for oversight of COVID-19 response. The Office of the Inspector General (OIG) released its <u>strategic plan</u> for oversight of COVID-19 response and recovery, with goals focused on protecting people, funds, and infrastructure, and promoting effectiveness. The OIG notes that it will advance each goal using risk assessment and data analytics to identify, monitor, and target potential fraud, waste, and abuse affecting HHS programs and beneficiaries and to promote the effectiveness of HHS's COVID-19 response and recovery programs.
