






OPERATIONS

CMS updates reporting requirements in nursing homes. CMS today issued a <u>memo</u> on the interim final rule updating requirements for notification of confirmed and suspected COVID-19 cases in nursing homes. Among the updates:

- <u>COVID-19 Reporting Requirements:</u> CMS is requiring nursing homes to report COVID-19 facility data to the CDC and to residents, their representatives, and families of residents in facilities. Facilities must submit their first set of data by 11:59 p.m. Sunday, May 17, 2020. To be compliant with the new requirement, facilities must submit the data through the NHSN reporting system at least once every seven days.
- Enforcement: Failure to report can result in an enforcement action.
- <u>Updated Survey Tools:</u> CMS has updated the COVID-19 Focused Survey for Nursing Homes, Entrance Conference Worksheet, COVID-19 Focused Survey Protocol, and Summary of the COVID-19 Focused Survey for Nursing Homes to reflect COVID-19 reporting requirements.
- <u>Transparency:</u> CMS will begin posting data from the CDC National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN) for viewing by facilities, stakeholders, or the general public.

New resource on serologic tests and surveillance strategy for COVID-19. The CDC recently launched a webpage to provide information about an agency-developed serologic test to detect SARS-CoV-2 antibodies. CDC says its test has a specificity of greater than 99% and a sensitivity of 96% based on initial tests. The test is not currently designed for individual use. Rather, CDC plans to use its antibody testing as part of a broad surveillance effort to better understand how much of the U.S. population has been infected with SARS-CoV-2 and how the virus is spreading through the population over time. CDC is also collaborating with other government agencies to evaluate commercially developed serology assays. PLANNING

Ongoing data reporting. Continue daily reporting of available resources and response data, including:

- <u>Juvare/EMResource</u>: Continue to report bed availability and ventilator capacity by 8:00 a.m. daily.
- <u>PPE Survey Tool:</u> PPE data will be reported to a <u>new PPE Survey Tool</u> instead of EMResource.
- <u>COVID-19 Patient Survey Tool:</u> Used to collect hospitalization data, and only to be used at the direction of DPHHS officials following acquisition of confirmed COVID-19 patient.

LOGISTICS

Submit PPE needs to DES coordinator in order to ensure allocation. In order to receive an allocation of emergency PPE, healthcare organizations MUST <u>submit needs to their local DES coordinator</u>. Allocation is ongoing and supplies are limited.

FINANCE & ADMINISTRATION

Distribution of Coronavirus Relief Fund to Native American tribes. Treasury Secretary Steven Mnuchin and Secretary of the Interior David Bernhardt issued a <u>joint statement</u> regarding the distribution of the Coronavirus Relief Fund (\$8 billion made available in the CARES Act) to Native American tribes.

- <u>Population Allocation</u>: 60 percent of the \$8 billion will be distributed based on Census population data used in the distribution of the Indian Housing Block Grant, subject to a floor of \$100,000. These payments will begin on May 5.
- Employment Allocation: 40 percent of the \$8 billion will be distributed based on the total number of persons employed by the Indian tribe and any tribally-owned entity, and further data to be collected on coronavirus-related expenses. These payments will be made at a later date (not specified).
