



OPERATIONS

Updated CDC list of people at risk for severe COVID-19 illness eschews specific age thresholds. The CDC has updated and expanded its list of people at risk of severe COVID-19 illness, the agency [said](#) yesterday. CDC removed a specific age threshold for those more susceptible to COVID-19 infection as part of the update. Instead, CDC said the risk of severe illness increases steadily the older an

individual is, mainly because underlying health conditions develop as a person ages. In addition, CDC said it updated the list of health conditions that could exacerbate COVID-19 illness, including chronic kidney disease and Type 2 diabetes. "We have to recognize reality," [said](#) CDC Director Robert Redfield, M.D. "Our nation isn't as healthy as some other nations, particularly if you look at obesity and some other medical conditions."

COVID-19 'cocktail' therapy moves to clinical trial. A therapeutic, two-antibody COVID-19 treatment "cocktail" from Regeneron and the Biomedical Advanced Research and Development Authority moved to its first clinical trial, the developers earlier this month [announced](#). The REGN-COV2 treatment contains two neutralizing monoclonal antibodies. It is believed to have the potential to be one of the first therapeutics specifically designed to inhibit SARS-COV-2.

FDA adds portable resuscitator to ventilator EUA list. The FDA Thursday [added](#) the AustinP51 emergency-use system to its list of ventilator authorized for emergency use in healthcare settings to treat adults during the COVID-19 pandemic. The device is a portable emergency use resuscitator designed to provide either continuous or intermittent ventilatory support for patients requiring mechanical ventilation through volume control.

PLANNING

Continue resource reporting to State. The following reporting requirements are in effect. For questions, please contact your [Regional Coordinator](#).

- **Hospitals:** Continue reporting to Juvare/EMResource as follows:
 - Daily: Bed and ventilator counts
 - Weekly (every Friday): PPE
 - Following treatment of COVID-19 patient(s): COVID-19 patient data, as directed by public health officials
- **Long-Term Care Facilities:** Bed and PPE counts to be reported weekly on Fridays. Regional Coordinators will email out a survey link weekly to each facility for bed and PPE data.

LOGISTICS

Streamlined sign-up process for Battelle mask decontamination program.

Battelle and Montana DES have simplified the sign-up process for participation in the Critical Care Decontamination System (CCDS) for NIOSH-approved N95 masks. Get started with the [4-step sign-up process](#).

Submit PPE needs to DES coordinator in order to ensure allocation. In order to receive an allocation of emergency PPE, healthcare organizations MUST [submit needs to their local DES coordinator](#).

FINANCE & ADMINISTRATION

AMA releases CPT code for antigen tests. The American Medical Association Thursday [announced](#) a new Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) code (87426) for reporting antigen testing to detect SARS-CoV-2 infection on medical claims. The FDA last month issued the first [emergency use authorization](#) for a COVID-19 antigen test, which can quickly detect the SARS-CoV-2 virus in a nasal swab sample.

Nearly 487,000 enroll in HealthCare.gov coverage in April. More than 892,000 consumers in states using the HealthCare.gov platform gained 2020 coverage since the end of open enrollment through May by using a Special Enrollment Period, a 27% increase from the same period last year, according to a [report](#) released yesterday by CMS. Almost 487,000 enrollees used the SEP for people who recently lost other qualifying health coverage, with the largest monthly gain in April. Consumers who experience one of [six types of life events](#) can select a plan during an SEP.
