


New HHS data reporting platform - Single data entry fulfills state and federal requirements. As announced to MHA member CEOs this week, MHA has purchased a new HHS Data Reporting Platform with COVID-19 grant funding. This creates a single, secure data entry point to fulfill both state and federal requirements, including state PPE resource allocation and HHS Teletracking mandates. This new single-entry system is especially critical with CMS' new rules that require such reporting as a Condition of Participation for Medicare and Medicaid. Hospitals will face possible termination of Medicare and Medicaid payments if unable to correct reporting deficiencies. See the complete details on the new platform [here](#).

Beginning today September 8, 2020 hospitals should utilize EMResource for statewide bed availability, PPE and Remdisivir data, as well as, all TeleTracking data points, including HHS lab testing. Upon entering HHS data into EMResource, Juvare will automatically upload data to TeleTracking on behalf of your facility daily. Facilities may continue entering their own data into TeleTracking if they choose. All laboratories conducting COVID-19 testing and reporting patient-specific results – including hospital labs, nursing homes, and other facilities conducting testing for COVID-19 – will be required to comply. If a laboratory does not report the required information, CMS will impose a civil monetary penalty in the amount of \$1,000 a day for the first day, and \$500 for each subsequent day.

- **Long-Term Care Facilities:** Bed and PPE counts to be reported weekly on Fridays. Use this [survey link](#) weekly to report bed and PPE data.

FINANCE & ADMINISTRATION

MedPAC commissioners examine impact of COVID-19 on Medicare providers and enrollees, call for more detailed analysis of CARES Act provider funds. The Medicare Payment Advisory Commission ([MedPAC](#)) convened a [session](#) to discuss issues surrounding the uncertainty caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. These issues included the pandemic's effects on beneficiaries and providers in Medicare, as well as eventual effects on costs, access, and providers' financial performance.

MedPAC commissioners support policy option for Part B coverage for all vaccines without cost sharing. The Medicare Payment Advisory Commission ([MedPAC](#)) convened a session to [examine](#) potential policy options for Medicare coverage of vaccines. The Commissioners universally supported the policy option that moves all vaccine coverage to Part B with no cost sharing in order to increase access, but the Commissioners suggested that a new pricing mechanism, such as basing prices on average sales prices (ASP), be explored to better control costs.

MedPAC commissioners expresses support for a limited telehealth expansion after the COVID-19 public health emergency. The Medicare Payment Advisory Commission ([MedPAC](#)) convened a session to [examine](#) the expansion of telehealth in Medicare during the COVID-19 public health emergency (PHE) and how to make some of the flexibilities permanent. MedPAC staff presented policy option in which providers who participate in advanced alternative payment models (A-APMs) are permitted to continue the telehealth flexibilities, while fee-for-services (FFS) providers revert to pre-public health emergency telehealth rules or limited expansions.
