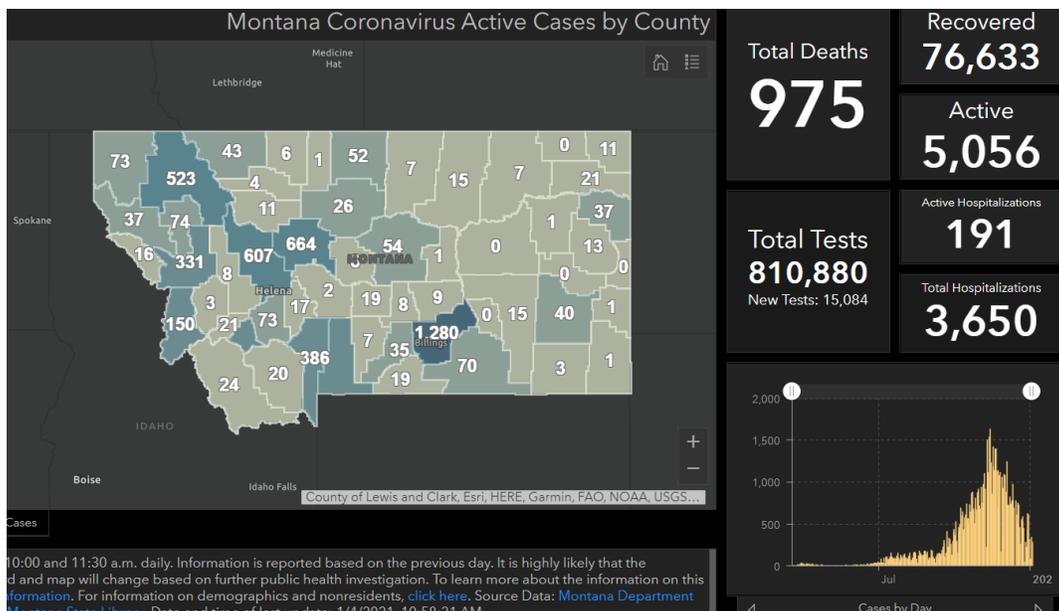

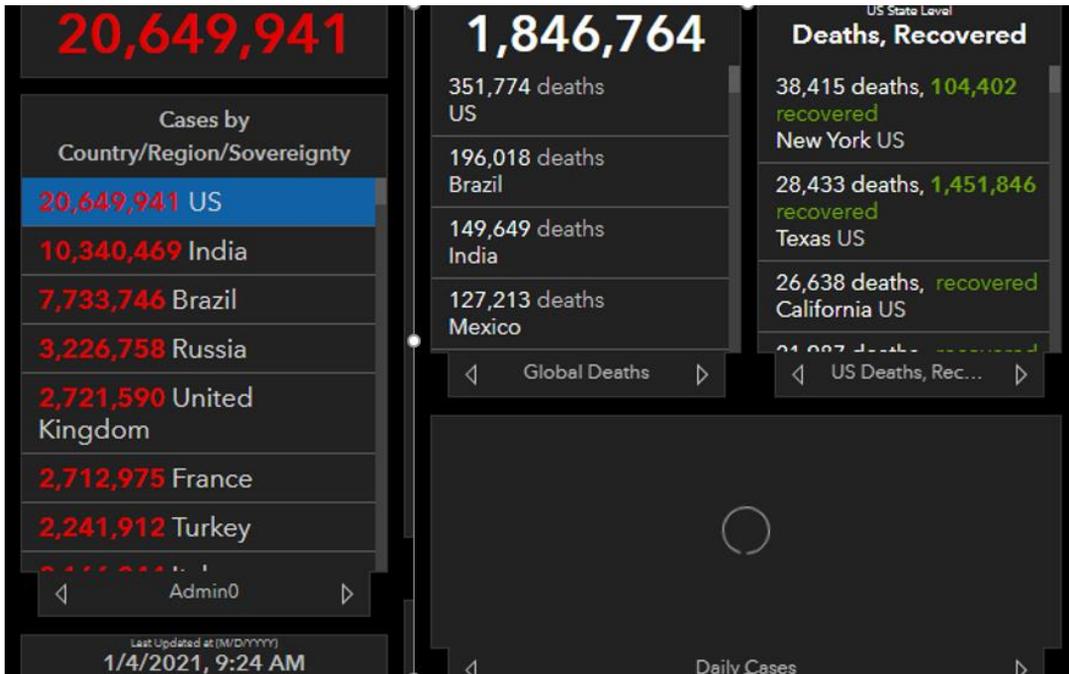
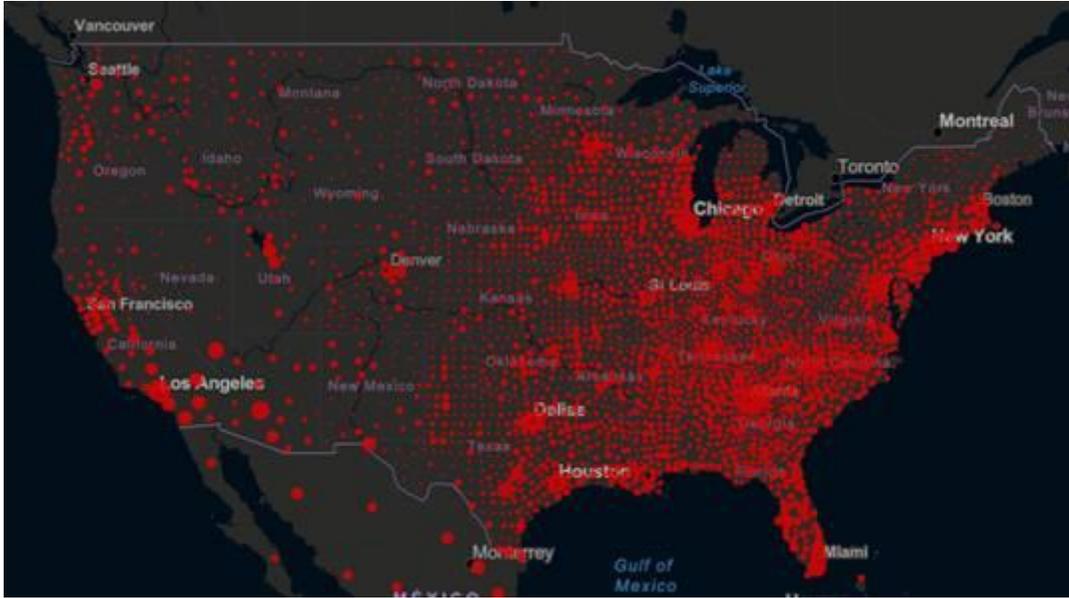

OPERATIONS

Updated COVID-19 vaccination distribution plan released. On Thursday, December 31, 2020 former Governor Bullock announced the state's COVID-19 vaccine distribution plan was updated to incorporate the new federal recommendations for allocation to critical groups in Montana and an estimated timeline.

The [updated plan](#) outlines an estimated timeline for vaccine distribution in Phases 1a, 1b, 1c and then the last phase (Phase 2) when vaccines are expected to be available to all Montanans late spring or early summer 2021.

Montana has launched Phase 1a that targets frontline healthcare workers and staff and residents of long-term care facilities. With a total of 16,990 healthcare personnel in Montana having now received their first vaccination dose, this phase has been expanded to include additional healthcare workers with direct patient contact. Updated analysis of COVID-19 cases in Montana. Montana DPHHS has released an updated epidemiological review of COVID-19 cases in the state. The [report](#) is based on COVID-19 case information available as of December 25.

PLANNING

HHS issues updated COVID-19 data reporting guidance. HHS on Nov. 9 updated its [guidance to hospitals](#) on the reporting of COVID-19-related data. The guidance includes two key changes stemming from the CMS' Dec. 2 [interim final rule](#) expanding the requirement for hospitals to report COVID-19 data. Influenza data fields will be mandatory starting on Friday, December 18. Therapeutic data fields are now optional, but will likely be mandatory beginning on Friday, January 8.

HHS data reporting platform - Single data entry fulfills state and federal requirements. MHA has purchased a new HHS Data Reporting Platform with COVID-19 grant funding. This creates a single, secure data entry point to fulfill both state and federal requirements, including state PPE resource allocation and HHS Teletracking mandates. This single-entry system is especially critical with CMS' rules that require such reporting as a Condition of Participation for Medicare and Medicaid. Hospitals will face possible termination of Medicare and Medicaid payments if unable to correct reporting deficiencies. See the complete details on the new platform [here](#).

As of September 8, 2020 hospitals should utilize EMResource for statewide bed availability, PPE and Remdisivir data, as well as, all TeleTracking data points, including HHS lab testing. Upon entering HHS data into EMResource, Juvare will automatically upload data to TeleTracking on behalf of your facility daily. Facilities may continue entering their own data into TeleTracking if they choose. All

laboratories conducting COVID-19 testing and reporting patient-specific results – including hospital labs, nursing homes, and other facilities conducting testing for COVID-19 – will be required to comply. If a laboratory does not report the required information, CMS will impose a civil monetary penalty in the amount of \$1,000 a day for the first day, and \$500 for each subsequent day.

As of October 1, 2020 long-term care facilities must report all PPE and bed reporting to EMResources. The previous weekly is inactive on October 1, 2020. Facilities that need assistance should email hppcoordinators@mtha.org.

LOGISTICS

State of Montana launches COVID-19 crisis counseling call center. The State of Montana has received a FEMA/SAMHSA disaster relief grant to provide COVID-19 crisis counseling to Montanans facing the mental health impacts of this pandemic. Montana Crisis Recovery is free and anonymous support available to all Montanans. Please share the [flyer](#) with staff, other first responders, family and friends. This program is managed by the Addictive and Mental Disorders Division of the Department of Public Health and Human Services.

Submit PPE needs to DES coordinator in order to ensure allocation. Until further notice, healthcare organizations MUST [submit needs to their local DES coordinator](#) in order to receive an allocation of emergency PPE.

FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION

CMS COVID-19 vaccines coding and billing resources. During the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency (PHE), Medicare will cover and pay for the administration of the Moderna and Pfizer COVID-19 vaccines (when furnished consistent with the EUA). Review CMS' updated [payment and HCPCS Level I CPT code structure](#) for specific COVID-19 vaccine information. Only bill for the vaccine administration codes when you submit claims to Medicare; don't include the vaccine product codes when the vaccines are free. CMS announces Acute Hospital Care At Home program. CMS on Nov. 25 [announced](#) the Acute Hospital Care At Home program for Medicare patients. The

program expands on the successful Hospital Without Walls program authorized in March. CMS approved waivers for six health systems with extensive experience providing acute hospital care at home to participate immediately. Other hospitals and health systems may [submit a waiver request](#) online.

PYA releases article on PRF take-aways from Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021. On Sunday, Dec. 27, the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 was signed into law. In 5600+ pages, the Act includes material changes to aspects of the CARES Act Provider Relief Fund (PRF), the Payroll Protection Program (PPP), the 2021 Medicare Physician Fee Schedule, and out-of-network billing.
